11	magistrate shall provide:
12	(1) to the attorney representing the state, reasonable
13	notice of the proposed bail reduction; and
14	(2) on request of the attorney representing the state
15	or the defendant or the defendant's counsel, an opportunity for a
16	hearing concerning the proposed bail reduction.
17	SECTION 2. This Act takes effect September 1, 2005.
