- 4 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:
- 5 SECTION 1. Section 15.02, Penal Code, is amended by
- 6 amending Subsection (d) and adding Subsection (e) to read as
- 7 follows:
- 8 (d) Except as provided by Subsection (e), an [An] offense
- 9 under this section is one category lower than the most serious
- 10 felony that is the object of the conspiracy, and if the most serious
- 11 felony that is the object of the conspiracy is a state jail felony,
- 12 the offense is a Class A misdemeanor.
- (e) If the felony that is the object of the conspiracy is the
- 14 manufacture of a controlled substance proscribed by Section
- 15 481.112, Health and Safety Code, an offense under this section is
- 16 the same category as the felony that is the object of the
- 17 conspiracy.
- SECTION 2. (a) The change in law made by this Act applies
- only to an offense committed on or after September 1, 2005.
- 20 (b) An offense committed before September 1, 2005, is
- 21 covered by the law in effect when the offense was committed, and the
- 22 former law is continued in effect for that purpose. For purposes of
- this section, an offense was committed before September 1, 2005, if
- 24 any element of the offense was committed before that date.
