- Sec. 130.0845. REMOVAL OF TRUSTEE FOR NONATTENDANCE OF BOARD MEETINGS. (a) It is a ground for removal of a member of the board of trustees of a junior college district that the member is absent from more than half of the regularly scheduled board meetings that the member is eligible to attend during a calendar year, not counting an absence for which the member is excused by a majority vote of the board.
- 14 (b) The validity of an action of the board of trustees is not
 15 affected by the fact that the action is taken when a ground for
 16 removal of a member of the board exists.
- 17 (c) A member of a board of trustees may be removed for a

 18 ground provided by this section, using the procedures provided by

 19 Subchapter B, Chapter 87, Local Government Code, for removing a

 20 county official.
- SECTION 2. The change in law made by this Act applies to an individual who is elected or appointed to the board of trustees of a junior college district before, on, or after the effective date of this Act.
