5	SECTION 1. Subchapter E, Chapter 130, Education Code, is
6	amended by adding Section 130.0845 to read as follows:
7	Sec. 130.0845. REMOVAL OF TRUSTEE FOR NONATTENDANCE OF
8	BOARD MEETINGS. (a) It is a ground for removal of a member of the
9	board of trustees of a junior college district that the member is
10	absent from more than half of the regularly scheduled board
11	meetings that the member is eligible to attend during a calendar
12	year, not counting an absence for which the member is excused by a
13	majority vote of the board.
14	(b) The validity of an action of the board of trustees is not
15	affected by the fact that the action is taken when a ground for
16	removal of a member of the board exists.
17	(c) A member of a board of trustees may be removed for a
18	ground provided by this section, using the procedures provided by
19	Subchapter B, Chapter 87, Local Government Code, for removing a
20	county official.
21	SECTION 2. The change in law made by this Act applies to an
22	individual who is elected or appointed to the board of trustees of a
23	junior college district before, on, or after the effective date of
24	this Act.
