- 4 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:
- 5 SECTION 1. Section 46.033, Education Code, is amended to
- 6 read as follows:
- 7 Sec. 46.033. ELIGIBLE BONDS. Bonds, including bonds issued
- 8 under Section 45.006, are eligible to be paid with state and local
- 9 funds under this subchapter if:
- 10 (1) the district made payments on the bonds during the
- 11 <u>school year that began in</u> the <u>second year of the preceding state</u>
- 12 fiscal biennium [2002-2003 school year] or taxes levied to pay the
- 13 principal of and interest on the bonds were included in the
- 14 district's audited debt service collections for that school year;
- 15 and
- 16 (2) the district does not receive state assistance
- 17 under Subchapter A for payment of the principal and interest on the
- 18 bonds.
- SECTION 2. Section 46.034(c), Education Code, is amended
- 20 to read as follows:
- 21 (c) If the amount required to pay the principal of and
- interest on eligible bonds in a school year is less than the amount
- of payments made by the district on the bonds during the [2002-2003]
- 24 school year that began in the second year of the preceding state

- 1 <u>fiscal biennium</u> or the district's audited debt service collections
- 2 for that school year, the district may not receive aid in excess of
- 3 the amount that, when added to the district's local revenue for the
- 4 school year, equals the amount required to pay the principal of and
- 5 interest on the bonds.
- 6 SECTION 3. This Act takes effect September 1, 2005.
