- 2 relating to trustees of military reservation school districts.
- 3 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:
- 4 SECTION 1. Subsection (b), Section 11.352, Education Code,
- 5 is amended to read as follows:
- 6 (b) For each military reservation school district, the 7 State Board of Education may appoint a board of three or five
- 8 trustees. Enlisted military personnel <u>and military officers</u> may be
- 9 appointed to the school board. A majority of the trustees appointed
- 10 for the district must be civilians and all may be civilians. The
- 11 trustees shall be selected from a list of persons who are qualified
- 12 to serve as members of a school district board of trustees under
- 13 Section 11.061 and who live or are employed on the military
- 14 reservation. The list shall be furnished to the board by the
- 15 commanding officer of the military reservation. The trustees
- 16 appointed serve terms of two years.
- 17 SECTION 2. This Act takes effect immediately if it receives
- 18 a vote of two-thirds of all the members elected to each house, as
- 19 provided by Section 39, Article III, Texas Constitution. If this
- 20 Act does not receive the vote necessary for immediate effect, this
- 21 Act takes effect September 1, 2005.
