A BILL TO BE ENTITLED

AN ACT

2 relating to trustees of military reservation school districts.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:

4 SECTION 1. Section 11.352(b), Education Code, is amended to 5 read as follows:

(b) For each military reservation school district, the 6 State Board of Education may appoint a board of three or five 7 trustees. Enlisted military personnel and military officers may be 8 appointed to the school board. A majority of the trustees appointed 9 for the district must be civilians and all may be civilians. 10 The trustees shall be selected from a list of persons who are qualified 11 12 to serve as members of a school district board of trustees under 13 Section 11.061 and who live or are employed on the military reservation. The list shall be furnished to the board by the 14 commanding officer of the military reservation. 15 The trustees appointed serve terms of two years. 16

17 SECTION 2. This Act takes effect immediately if it receives 18 a vote of two-thirds of all the members elected to each house, as 19 provided by Section 39, Article III, Texas Constitution. If this 20 Act does not receive the vote necessary for immediate effect, this 21 Act takes effect September 1, 2005.
