1-6 A BILL TO BE ENTITLED
1-7 AN ACT

1-8 relating to trustees of military reservation school districts.

1-9 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:

1-10 SECTION 1. Subsection (b), Section 11.352, Education Code,
1-11 is amended to read as follows:

1-12 (b) For each military reservation school district, the
1-13 State Board of Education may appoint a board of three or five
1-14 trustees. Enlisted military personnel and military officers may be
1-15 appointed to the school board. A majority of the trustees appointed
1-16 for the district must be civilians and all may be civilians. The
1-17 trustees shall be selected from a list of persons who are qualified
1-18 to serve as members of a school district board of trustees under
1-19 Section 11.061 and who live or are employed on the military
1-20 reservation. The list shall be furnished to the board by the
1-21 commanding officer of the military reservation. The trustees
1-22 appointed serve terms of two years.

1-23 SECTION 2. This Act takes effect immediately if it receives
1-24 a vote of two-thirds of all the members elected to each house, as
1-25 provided by Section 39, Article III, Texas Constitution. If this
1-26 Act does not receive the vote necessary for immediate effect, this
1-27 Act takes effect September 1, 2005.

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
