- 5 SECTION 1. Section 552.119, Government Code, is amended to 6 read as follows:
- 7 Sec. 552.119. EXCEPTION: PHOTOGRAPH OF PEACE OFFICER [OR
- 8 CERTAIN SECURITY CUARDS]. (a) A photograph that depicts a peace
- 9 officer as defined by Article 2.12, Code of Criminal Procedure, [or
- 10 a security officer commissioned under Section 51.212, Education
- 11 Code, the release of which would endanger the life or physical
- 12 safety of the officer, is excepted from the requirements of Section
- 13 552.021 unless:

- 14 (1) the officer is under indictment or charged with an
- 15 offense by information;
- 16 (2) the officer is a party in a [fire or police] civil
- 17 service hearing or a case in arbitration; or
- 18 (3) the photograph is introduced as evidence in a
- 19 judicial proceeding.
- 20 (b) A photograph excepted [exempt] from disclosure under
- 21 Subsection (a) may be made public only if the peace officer [or
- 22 security officer] gives written consent to the disclosure.
- 23 SECTION 2. This Act takes effect immediately if it receives
