- 2 relating to recording of aircraft repair and maintenance liens.
- 3 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:
- 4 SECTION 1. Section 70.303, Property Code, is amended to
- 5 read as follows:
- 6 Sec. 70.303. RECORDING OF LIEN. (a) A holder of a lien
- 7 under this subchapter may record the lien on the aircraft by filing
- 8 with the Federal Aviation Administration Aircraft Registry or the
- 9 secretary of state not later than the 180th day after the date of
- 10 the completion of the contractual storage period or the performance
- 11 of the last repair or maintenance a verified document in the form
- 12 and manner required by applicable federal or state laws and
- 13 regulations that states:
- 14 (1) the name, address, and telephone number of the
- 15 holder of the lien under this subchapter;
- 16 (2) the amount due for storage, fuel, repairs, or
- 17 maintenance;
- 18 (3) a complete description of the aircraft; and
- 19 (4) the name and address of the owner of the aircraft
- 20 and the number assigned the aircraft by the Federal Aviation
- 21 Administration, if known.
- 22 (b) The secretary of state shall maintain a record of
- 23 <u>information filed with the secretary of state under this section</u>
- 24 and index the records in the name of the owner of the aircraft.

- 1 SECTION 2. Section 70.304(a), Property Code, is amended to 2 read as follows:
- 3 (a) Not later than the 30th day after the date of the 4 completion of the contractual storage period or the performance of 5 the last fueling, repair, or maintenance, a holder of a lien under
- 6 this subchapter who retains possession of the aircraft shall notify
- 7 the owner shown on the certificate of registration and each holder
- 8 of a lien on the aircraft as shown by the records maintained for
- 9 that purpose by the Federal Aviation Administration Aircraft
- 10 Registry or the secretary of state. The notice must state:
- 11 (1) the name, address, and telephone number of the
- 12 holder of the lien under this subchapter;
- 13 (2) the amount due for storage, fuel, repairs, or
- 14 maintenance;
- 15 (3) a complete description of the aircraft; and
- 16 (4) the legal right of the holder of the lien under
- 17 this subchapter to sell the aircraft at public auction and apply the
- 18 proceeds to the amount due.
- 19 SECTION 3. The change in law made by this Act applies only
- 20 to an aircraft repair and maintenance lien that arises under
- 21 Subchapter D, Chapter 70, Property Code, on or after the effective
- 22 date of this Act. A lien that arises before the effective date of
- 23 this Act is governed by the law in effect immediately before that
- 24 date, and that law is continued in effect for that purpose.
- 25 SECTION 4. This Act takes effect immediately if it receives
- 26 a vote of two-thirds of all the members elected to each house, as
- 27 provided by Section 39, Article III, Texas Constitution. If this

- 1 Act does not receive the vote necessary for immediate effect, this
- 2 Act takes effect September 1, 2005.
