4 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:

5 SECTION 1. Subsection (a), Section 545.410, Transportation

Code, is amended to read as follows:

- 7 (a) An operator of a passenger car or light truck may not
- 8 draw a trailer, semitrailer, house trailer, or another motor
- 9 vehicle unless safety chains of a type approved by the department
- 10 are attached in a manner approved by the department from the
- 11 trailer, semitrailer, house trailer, or drawn motor vehicle to the
- 12 drawing vehicle. The department by rule shall exempt certain types
- 13 of trailers that exhibit adequate safety standards from the
- 14 requirements of this subsection [This subsection does not apply to
- 15 the drawing of a trailer or semitrailer used for agricultural
- 16 purposes].
- 17 SECTION 2. (a) The change in law made by this Act applies
- only to an offense committed on or after the effective date of this
- 19 Act. For purposes of this section, an offense is committed before
- 20 the effective date of this Act if any element of the offense occurs
- 21 before that date.
- 22 (b) An offense committed before the effective date of this
- 23 Act is covered by the law in effect when the offense was committed,
- 24 and the former law is continued in effect for that purpose.
