- 4 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:
- 5 SECTION 1. Section 156.002, Occupations Code, is amended by
- 6 adding Subsection (c) to read as follows:
- 7 (c) A physician who is at least 70 years of age may renew the
- 8 physician's registration permit without paying the fee for renewal
- 9 of a registration permit.
- 10 SECTION 2. The change in law made by this Act by the
- 11 enactment of Section 156.002(c), Occupations Code, applies to the
- 12 renewal of a registration permit that expires on or after the
- 13 effective date of this Act. A registration permit that expires
- 14 before the effective date of this Act is governed by the law in
- 15 effect on the date the registration permit expired, and the former
- 16 law is continued in effect for that purpose.
- 17 SECTION 3. This Act takes effect September 1, 2005.
