A BILL TO BE ENTITLED

- 2 relating to permissible uses of money in the comprehensive
- 3 rehabilitation fund.
- 4 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:
- 5 SECTION 1. Subsection (b), Section 111.060, Human Resources
- 6 Code, is amended to read as follows:
- 7 (b) The comptroller, on requisition by the commission,
- 8 shall draw a warrant on the fund for the amount specified in that
- 9 requisition for a use authorized in Section 111.052, except that
- 10 the total of warrants issued during a state fiscal year may not
- 11 exceed the amount appropriated for that fiscal year. At the end of
- 12 each state fiscal year, the comptroller shall transfer to the
- 13 General Revenue Fund any unexpended balance in the comprehensive
- rehabilitation fund that exceeds \$1.5 million [\\$500,000].
- SECTION 2. Subsection (d), Section 111.060, Human Resources
- 16 Code, is repealed.
- 17 SECTION 3. This Act takes effect immediately if it receives
- 18 a vote of two-thirds of all the members elected to each house, as
- 19 provided by Section 39, Article III, Texas Constitution. If this
- 20 Act does not receive the vote necessary for immediate effect, this
- 21 Act takes effect September 1, 2005.
