4	BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:
5	SECTION 1. Section 30.005, Education Code, is amended to

7	Sec. 30.005. TEXAS SCHOOL FOR THE BLIND AND VISUALLY
8	IMPAIRED MEMORANDUM OF UNDERSTANDING. The Texas Education Agency
9	and the Texas School for the Blind and Visually Impaired shall
10	develop, agree to, and by commissioner rule adopt [no later than
11	September 1, 1998, a memorandum of understanding to establish:
12	(1) the method for developing and reevaluating a set
13	of indicators of the quality of learning at the Texas School for the
14	Blind and Visually Impaired;
15	(2) the process for the agency to conduct and report on
16	an annual evaluation of the school's performance on the indicators;
17	(3) the requirements for the school's board to
18	publish, discuss, and disseminate an annual report describing the
19	educational performance of the school; [and]
20	(4) the process for the agency to:
21	(A) assign an accreditation status to the school;
22	(B) reevaluate the status on an annual basis; and
23	(C) if necessary, make on-site accreditation

- 1 (5) the type of information the school shall be 2 required to provide through the Public Education Information 3 Management System (PEIMS).
- SECTION 2. This Act takes effect immediately if it receives a vote of two-thirds of all the members elected to each house, as provided by Section 39, Article III, Texas Constitution. If this Act does not receive the vote necessary for immediate effect, this Act takes effect September 1, 2005.
