15	(2) the process for the agency to conduct and report on
16	an annual evaluation of the school's performance on the indicators;
17	(3) the requirements for the school's board to
18	publish, discuss, and disseminate an annual report describing the
19	educational performance of the school;

21	(A) assign an accreditation status to the school;
22	(B) reevaluate the status on an annual basis; and
23	(C) if necessary, make on-site accreditation

(5) [(4)] the type of information the school shall be
required to provide through the Public Education Information
Management System (PEIMS).

4 SECTION 2. This Act takes effect immediately if it receives 5 a vote of two-thirds of all the members elected to each house, as 6 provided by Section 39, Article III, Texas Constitution. If this 7 Act does not receive the vote necessary for immediate effect, this 8 Act takes effect September 1, 2005.
