- 2 relating to the amount of money available to certain disabled peace
- 3 officers from the compensation to victims of crime fund.
- 4 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:
- 5 SECTION 1. Article 56.542(k), Code of Criminal Procedure, 6 is amended to read as follows:
- 7 (k) The limits on compensation imposed by Article 56.42 do
- 8 not apply to payments made under this article, but the total
- 9 aggregate amount of all annual payments made to an individual peace
- officer under this section may not exceed \$250,000 [\$200,000].
- 11 SECTION 2. The change in law made by this Act applies to an
- 12 application for compensation for criminally injurious conduct
- occurring before, on, or after the effective date of this Act.
- 14 SECTION 3. This Act takes effect immediately if it receives
- 15 a vote of two-thirds of all the members elected to each house, as
- 16 provided by Section 39, Article III, Texas Constitution. If this
- 17 Act does not receive the vote necessary for immediate effect, this
- 18 Act takes effect September 1, 2005.
