- BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:
- 5 SECTION 1. Subchapter A, Chapter 38, Education Code, is 6 amended by adding Section 38.022 to read as follows:
- 7 Sec. 38.022. INCLUSION OF BODY MASS INDEX IN NOTICE OF
- 8 STUDENT'S PERFORMANCE. (a) The written notice of a student's
- 9 performance a school district gives as required by Section
- 10 28.022(a)(2) must also include a statement of:
- 11 (1) the student's body mass index; and
- 12 (2) whether the student's body mass index is below,
- within, or above the normal range according to a body mass index
- 14 value table approved for use by the district's local school health
- 15 advisory council.

- 16 (b) A school district shall weigh each student and compute
- 17 the student's body mass index in a manner designed to respect the
- 18 <u>student's privacy.</u>
- 19 (c) If a school district determines that a student's body
- 20 mass index is above the normal range, the district shall provide the
- 21 student's parent with written information approved by the
- 22 district's local school health advisory council that explains the
- connection between a body mass index that is above the normal range
- 24 and obesity, diabetes, and other health problems.

- 1 SECTION 2. The heading to Section 28.022, Education Code,
- 2 is amended to read as follows:
- 3 Sec. 28.022. NOTICE TO PARENT OF STUDENT [UNSATISFACTORY]
- 4 PERFORMANCE AND ADDITIONAL INFORMATION.
- 5 SECTION 3. Section 28.022, Education Code, is amended by
- 6 adding Subsection (a-1) to read as follows:
- 7 (a-1) The notice required under Subsection (a)(2) must
- 8 include the information required by Section 38.022(a).
- 9 SECTION 4. Section 28.022, Education Code, as amended by
- 10 this Act, and Section 38.022, Education Code, as added by this Act,
- apply beginning with the 2005-2006 school year.
- 12 SECTION 5. This Act takes effect immediately if it receives
- 13 a vote of two-thirds of all the members elected to each house, as
- 14 provided by Section 39, Article III, Texas Constitution. If this
- 15 Act does not receive the vote necessary for immediate effect, this
- 16 Act takes effect September 1, 2005.
