A BILL TO BE ENTITLED

AN ACT

- 2 relating to the time allowed for execution of a search warrant 3 issued to obtain a specimen for DNA analysis.
- 4 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:
- 5 SECTION 1. Article 18.07, Code of Criminal Procedure, is 6 amended to read as follows:
- 7 Art. 18.07. DAYS ALLOWED FOR WARRANT TO RUN. (a) The time 8 allowed for the execution of a search warrant [shall be three whole
- 9 days], exclusive of the day of its issuance and of the day of its
- 10 execution, is:

- 11 (1) 20 whole days if the warrant is issued solely to
- 12 <u>search for and seize evidentiary items or specimens for DNA</u>
- analysis and comparison, including blood and saliva samples; or
- (2) three whole days if the warrant is issued for a
- purpose other than that described by Subdivision (1).
- 16 <u>(b)</u> The magistrate issuing a search warrant under [the 17 provisions of] this chapter shall endorse on the [such] search warrant the date and hour of its [the] issuance [of the same].
- 19 SECTION 2. The change in law made by this Act applies only
- to a search warrant that is issued on or after September 1, 2005. A
- 21 search warrant that is issued before September 1, 2005, is covered
- 22 by the law in effect when the warrant was issued, and the former law
- 23 is continued in effect for that purpose.
- SECTION 3. This Act takes effect September 1, 2005.
