A BILL TO BE ENTITLED

AN ACT

- 4 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:
- 5 SECTION 1. Section 209.009, Property Code, is amended to 6 read as follows:
- 7 Sec. 209.009. FORECLOSURE SALE PROHIBITED IN CERTAIN
- 8 CIRCUMSTANCES. (a) A property owners' association may not
- 9 foreclose a property owners' association's assessment lien if the
- 10 debt securing the lien consists solely of:
- 11 (1) fines assessed by the association; or
- 12 (2) attorney's fees incurred by the association solely
- 13 associated with fines assessed by the association.
- (b) Unless otherwise provided in writing by the property
- owner, a payment received by a property owners' association from
- 16 the owner shall be applied to the owner's debt in the following
- 17 order of priority:
- 18 (1) any delinquent assessment;
- 19 <u>(2)</u> any current assessment;
- 20 (3) any fines assessed by the association; and
- 21 <u>(4) any attorney's fees incurred by the association</u>
- 22 solely associated with fines assessed by the association.
- (c) Subsection (b) does not apply to a payment received by a
- 24 property owners' association if:

- 1 (1) membership in the property owners' association is 2 mandatory for owners or for a defined class of owners of private
- 3 real property in a defined geographic area in a county with a
- 4 population of 3.3 million or more or in a county adjacent to a
- 5 county with a population of 3.3 million or more;
- 6 (2) the property owners' association has the power to
- 7 make mandatory special assessments for capital improvements or
- 8 mandatory regular assessments; and
- 9 (3) the amount of the mandatory special or regular
- 10 assessments is or has ever been based in whole or in part on the
- 11 value at which the state or a local governmental body assesses the
- 12 property for purposes of ad valorem taxation under Section 20,
- 13 Article VIII, Texas Constitution.
- 14 SECTION 2. This Act applies to a payment received by a
- 15 property owners' association on or after the effective date of this
- 16 Act. A payment received before the effective date of this Act is
- 17 governed by the law in effect when the payment was received, and the
- 18 former law is continued in effect for that purpose.
- 19 SECTION 3. This Act takes effect September 1, 2005.
