## A BILL TO BE ENTITLED

1 AN ACT

2 relating to local government authorization of charitable

3 solicitation by a pedestrian.

4 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:

5 SECTION 1. Section 552.007(a), Transportation Code, is

6 amended to read as follows:

- 7 (a) A person may not stand in a roadway to solicit a ride,
- 8 contribution, employment, or business from an occupant of a
- 9 vehicle, except that a person may stand in a roadway to solicit a
- 10 charitable contribution if authorized to do so by the local
- 11 authority having jurisdiction over the roadway. The local
- 12 authority shall grant this authorization if the organization for
- which the solicitation is to be made provides to the local authority
- 14 advance proof of liability insurance in the amount of at least \$1
- 15 million to cover damages that may arise from the solicitation.
- 16 SECTION 2. This Act takes effect immediately if it receives
- 17 a vote of two-thirds of all the members elected to each house, as
- 18 provided by Section 39, Article III, Texas Constitution. If this
- 19 Act does not receive the vote necessary for immediate effect, this
- 20 Act takes effect September 1, 2005.
