4	BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:
5	SECTION 1. Chapter 437, Health and Safety Code, is amended
6	by adding Section 437.020 to read as follows:
7	Sec. 437.020. PRODUCE SAMPLES AT MUNICIPALLY OWNED FARMERS'
8	MARKETS. (a) Except as provided by Subsection (b):
9	(1) this chapter does not regulate the provision of
10	samples of produce to consumers at a municipally owned farmers'
11	market; and
12	(2) a rule adopted under state law may not regulate the
13	provision of samples of produce to consumers at a municipally owned
14	<pre>farmers' market.</pre>
15	(b) Produce samples may only be distributed at a municipally
16	owned farmers' market if the following sanitary conditions exist:
17	(1) produce samples must be kept in approved, clean,
18	and covered containers;
19	(2) produce samples must be distributed in a sanitary
20	<pre>manner;</pre>
21	(3) clean, disposable plastic gloves must be used when
22	<pre>cutting produce samples;</pre>
23	(4) produce intended for sampling must be washed in
24	potable water of any soil or other material so that it is wholesome

- 1 and safe for consumption;
- 2 (5) potable water must be available for hand washing
- 3 and sanitizing as approved by the local or state enforcement
- 4 agency;
- 5 (6) potentially hazardous cut produce, as determined
- 6 by rule of the department, must be maintained at or below 41 degrees
- 7 Fahrenheit, and produce samples must be disposed of within two
- 8 hours after cutting;
- 9 (7) utensil and hand washing water must be disposed of
- in a facility connected to the public sewer system or in a manner
- approved by the local or state enforcement agency; and
- 12 (8) utensils and cutting surfaces must be smooth,
- 13 nonabsorbent, and easily cleaned or disposed of as approved by the
- 14 local or state enforcement agency.
- 15 SECTION 2. This Act takes effect immediately if it receives
- 16 a vote of two-thirds of all the members elected to each house, as
- 17 provided by Section 39, Article III, Texas Constitution. If this
- 18 Act does not receive the vote necessary for immediate effect, this
- 19 Act takes effect September 1, 2005.
