## A BILL TO BE ENTITLED

1	AN ACT
2	relating to the removal of data from data processing equipment
3	disposed of or transferred by state agencies.
4	BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:
5	SECTION 1. Subchapter F, Chapter 2054, Government Code, is
6	amended by adding Section 2054.130 to read as follows:
7	Sec. 2054.130. REMOVAL OF DATA FROM DATA PROCESSING
8	EQUIPMENT; RULES. (a) A state agency shall permanently remove
9	data from data processing equipment before disposing of or
10	otherwise transferring the equipment to a person who is not a state
11	agency or other agent of the state. This section applies only to
12	equipment that will not be owned by the state after the disposal or
13	other transfer.
14	(b) The department shall adopt rules to implement this
15	section. The rules must include rules that:
16	(1) specify what types of data processing equipment
17	are covered by this section, including computer hard drives and
18	other memory components;
19	(2) explain the acceptable methods for removal of
20	data; and
21	(3) adopt appropriate forms for use by state agencies
22	in documenting the removal process, including forms for documenting
23	completion of the process.
24	SECTION 2. Not later than March 1, 2006, the Department of

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- 1 Information Resources shall adopt the rules required by Section
- 2 2054.130, Government Code, as added by this Act. A state agency is
- 3 not required to comply with Section 2054.130, Government Code,
- 4 until the department adopts the rules.
- 5 SECTION 3. This Act takes effect September 1, 2005.
