AN ACT

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- 2 relating to the creation of a program to educate the public on the
- 3 value of health coverage and to increase public awareness of health

- 5 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:
- 6 SECTION 1. Subtitle B, Title 5, Insurance Code, as
- 7 effective April 1, 2005, is amended by adding Chapter 524 to read as
- 8 follows:

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- 9 CHAPTER 524. HEALTH COVERAGE AWARENESS AND EDUCATION PROGRAM
- 10 Sec. 524.001. PROGRAM ESTABLISHED. (a) The department
- 11 shall develop and implement a health coverage public awareness and
- 12 education program that complies with this chapter. The program
- 13 must:
- 14 (1) increase public awareness of health coverage
- options available in this state;
- 16 (2) educate the public on the value of health
- 17 coverage; and
- 18 (3) provide information on health coverage options,
- 19 including health savings accounts and compatible high deductible
- 20 health benefit plans.
- 21 (b) The department may include information about specific
- 22 health coverage issuers but may not favor or endorse one particular
- 23 issuer over another.
- Sec. 524.002. PUBLIC SERVICE ANNOUNCEMENTS. The department

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shall develop and make public service announcements to educate 1 2 consumers and employers about the availability of health coverage 3 in this state. 4 Sec. 524.003. INTERNET WEBSITE; PUBLIC EDUCATION. (a) The 5 department shall develop an Internet website designed to educate the public about the availability of health coverage in this state, 6 7 including information about health savings accounts and compatible 8 high deductible health benefit plans. The department shall provide other appropriate 9 (b) education to the public regarding the value of health coverage. 10 Sec. 524.004. TASK FORCE. (a) The commissioner shall 11 12 appoint a task force to make recommendations regarding the health coverage public awareness and education program. The task force is 13 14 composed of: 15 (1) one representative from each of the following 16 groups or entities: 17 (A) health benefit coverage consumers; 18 (B) small employers; 19 (C) employers generally; 20 (D) insurance agents; 21 (E) the office of public insurance counsel; 22 (F) the Texas Health Insurance Risk Pool; 23 (G) physicians; 24 (H) advanced practice nurses; 25 (I) hospital trade associations; and 26 (J) medical units of institutions of higher

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education;

- 1 (2) a representative of the Health and Human Services
- 2 Commission responsible for programs under Medicaid and the
- 3 children's health insurance program; and
- 4 (3) one or more representatives of health benefit plan
- 5 issuers.
- 6 (b) The department shall consult the task force regarding
- 7 the content for the public service announcements, Internet website,
- 8 and educational materials required by this chapter. The
- 9 commissioner has authority to make final decisions as to what the
- 10 program's materials will contain.
- Sec. 524.005. FUNDING. The department may accept gifts and
- 12 grants from any party, including a health benefit plan issuer or a
- 13 foundation associated with a health benefit plan issuer, to assist
- 14 with funding the program. The department shall adopt rules
- 15 governing acceptance of donations that are consistent with Chapter
- 16 <u>575, Government Code</u>. Before adopting rules under this subsection,
- 17 the department shall:
- 18 (1) submit the proposed rules to the Texas Ethics
- 19 Commission for review; and
- 20 (2) consider the commission's recommendations
- 21 <u>regarding the regulations.</u>
- 22 SECTION 2. This Act takes effect immediately if it receives
- 23 a vote of two-thirds of all the members elected to each house, as
- 24 provided by Section 39, Article III, Texas Constitution. If this
- 25 Act does not receive the vote necessary for immediate effect, this
- 26 Act takes effect September 1, 2005.
