Sec. 76.404. PROGRAM ADMINISTRATION; RULES. (a) The director shall establish administrative procedures to carry out the

requirements of this subchapter.
(b) The commission shall adopt any rules necessary for the

administration of the program established under this subchapter.

Sec. 76.405. REPORT OF PROGRAM STATUS. (a) Not later than January 1, 2010, the department shall report to an advisory committee appointed by the presiding officer of the commission to

address issues relating to oysters in this state.

(b) The report under Subsection (a) must include an overview of the administration and status of the program established under this subchapter and information concerning the sociological and economic effects of the program.

(c) This section expires September 1, 2010.

SECTION 2. (a) As soon as practicable, the Parks and Wildlife Commission shall adopt rules necessary to administer the oyster license moratorium program established under Subchapter F, Chapter 76, Parks and Wildlife Code, as added by this Act.

(b) As soon as practicable after the effective date of this Act, the executive director of the Parks and Wildlife Commission shall adopt procedures for the election of the oyster license moratorium review board under Section 76.403, Parks and Wildlife Code, as added by this Act. As soon as practicable after the adoption of election procedures, but not later than November 1, 2005, the election of the oyster license moratorium review board must be held.

SECTION 3. This Act takes effect immediately if it receives a vote of two-thirds of all the members elected to each house, as provided by Section 39, Article III, Texas Constitution. If this Act does not receive the vote necessary for immediate effect, this Act takes effect September 1, 2005.
