## A BILL TO BE ENTITLED

⊥	AN ACT	

- 2 relating to authorizing The University of Texas Health Science
- 3 Center at Tyler to offer courses and degree programs in allied

- 5 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:
- 6 SECTION 1. Section 74.602, Education Code, is amended to 7 read as follows:
- 8 Sec. 74.602. <u>PURPOSES</u> [<del>PURPOSE</del>] OF HEALTH SCIENCE CENTER;
- 9 <u>DEGREE PROGRAMS</u>. (a) It is the policy of this state to provide a
- 10 program of treatment of the citizens of this state who are affected
- 11 with respiratory diseases. In pursuance of that policy, The
- 12 University of Texas Health Science Center at Tyler, among other
- 13 functions, shall serve as the primary facility in this state to:
- 14 (1) conduct research relating to respiratory
- 15 diseases;
- 16 (2) develop diagnostic and treatment techniques and
- 17 procedures for respiratory diseases;
- 18 (3) provide training and teaching programs; and
- 19 (4) provide diagnosis and treatment of inpatients and
- 20 outpatients with respiratory diseases.
- 21 (b) The center may provide education and training in allied
- 22 health and related health science fields, and for that purpose may
- 23 prescribe courses and conduct professional or other degree programs
- 24 in those fields. The center may prescribe a course or conduct a

- 1 degree program under this subsection jointly or in collaboration
- 2 with any other appropriate educational entity or institution.
- 3 (c) The degree programs to be offered under Subsection (b)
- 4 are subject to approval by the Texas Higher Education Coordinating
- 5 Board.
- 6 SECTION 2. This Act takes effect immediately if it receives
- 7 a vote of two-thirds of all the members elected to each house, as
- 8 provided by Section 39, Article III, Texas Constitution. If this
- 9 Act does not receive the vote necessary for immediate effect, this
- 10 Act takes effect on the 91st day after the last day of the
- 11 legislative session.
