- 4 SECTION 1. Subdivision (1), Section 396.001,

- 6 (1) "Automotive wrecking and salvage yard" means an
- 7 outdoor place where a person stores three or more wrecked vehicles
- 8 for the purpose of dismantling or wrecking the vehicles to remove
- 9 parts for sale or for use in [an] automotive repair or rebuilding
- 10 [business].
- 11 SECTION 2. Chapter 397, Transportation Code, is amended by
- 12 adding Section 397.014 to read as follows:
- 13 Sec. 397.014. INJUNCTION. (a) A person is entitled to an
- 14 <u>injunction to prohibit a violation or threatened violation of this</u>
- 15 chapter.
- 16 (b) The venue for the injunction proceeding is in the county
- 17 to which this chapter applies in which any part of the automotive
- 18 wrecking and salvage yard is located.
- 19 SECTION 3. This Act takes effect immediately if it receives
- 20 a vote of two-thirds of all the members elected to each house, as
- 21 provided by Section 39, Article III, Texas Constitution. If this
- 22 Act does not receive the vote necessary for immediate effect, this
- 23 Act takes effect September 1, 2005.
