1-6 A BILL TO BE ENTITLED
1-7 AN ACT

1-8 relating to an injunction to prevent violations by automotive
1-9 wrecking and salvage yards in certain counties.

1-10 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:

1-11 SECTION 1. Chapter 397, Transportation Code, is amended by
1-12 adding Section 397.014 to read as follows:

1-13 Sec. 397.014. INJUNCTION. (a) A person is entitled to an
1-14 injunction to prohibit a violation or threatened violation of this
1-15 chapter.

1-16 (b) The venue for the injunction proceeding is in the county
1-17 to which this chapter applies in which any part of the automotive
1-18 wrecking and salvage yard is located.

1-19 SECTION 2. This Act takes effect immediately if it receives
1-20 a vote of two-thirds of all the members elected to each house, as
1-21 provided by Section 39, Article III, Texas Constitution. If this
1-22 Act does not receive the vote necessary for immediate effect, this
1-23 Act takes effect September 1, 2005.
