- 7 SECTION 1. Section 87.841, Education Code, is amended by
- 8 amending Subsection (d) and adding Subsection (e) to read as

- 10 (d) Notwithstanding any other provision of this subchapter,
- 11 Texas A&M University--San Antonio may not operate as a general
- 12 academic teaching institution until the Texas Higher Education
- 13 Coordinating Board certifies that enrollment at the Texas A&M
- 14 University--Kingsville System Center--San Antonio has reached an
- 15 enrollment equivalent of:
- 16 (1) 1,000 full-time students for one semester if the
- 17 legislature authorizes revenue bonds to be issued to finance
- 18 educational and related facilities for the institution, and the
- 19 bonds are issued for that purpose; or
- 20 <u>(2)</u> 2,500 full-time students for one semester <u>if the</u>
- 21 conditions specified by Subdivision (1) are not satisfied.
- 22 (e) Notwithstanding any other law, Texas A&M
- 23 <u>University--San Antonio is not eligible to receive the small</u>
- 24 institution supplement under the Texas Higher Education

- 2 Formula during the state fiscal biennium beginning September 1,
- 3 2005. This subsection expires September 1, 2007.
- 4 SECTION 2. This Act takes effect immediately if it receives
- 5 a vote of two-thirds of all the members elected to each house, as
- 6 provided by Section 39, Article III, Texas Constitution. If this
- 7 Act does not receive the vote necessary for immediate effect, this
- 8 Act takes effect September 1, 2005.
