A BILL TO BE ENTITLED

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- 2 relating to the student enrollment required for the operation of
- 3 Texas A&M University--San Antonio and Texas A&M
- 4 University--Central Texas as independent general academic teaching

- 6 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:
- 7 SECTION 1. Subsection (d), Section 87.841, Education Code,
- 8 is amended to read as follows:
- 9 (d) Notwithstanding any other provision of this subchapter,
- 10 Texas A&M University--San Antonio may not operate as a general
- 11 academic teaching institution until the Texas Higher Education
- 12 Coordinating Board certifies that enrollment at the Texas A&M
- 13 University--Kingsville System Center--San Antonio has reached an
- 14 enrollment equivalent of:
- 15 (1) 1,000 full-time students for one semester if the
- 16 legislature authorizes revenue bonds to be issued to finance
- 17 educational and related facilities for the institution, and the
- 18 bonds are issued for that purpose; or
- 19 <u>(2)</u> 2,500 full-time students for one semester <u>if the</u>
- 20 conditions specified by Subdivision (1) are not satisfied.
- 21 SECTION 2. Subsection (d), Section 87.861, Education Code,
- 22 is amended to read as follows:
- 23 (d) Notwithstanding any other provision of this subchapter,
- 24 Texas A&M University--Central Texas may not operate as a general

- 1 academic teaching institution until the Texas Higher Education
- 2 Coordinating Board certifies that enrollment at the Tarleton State
- 3 University System Center--Central Texas in Killeen has reached an
- 4 enrollment equivalent of:
- 5 (1) 1,000 full-time students for one semester if the
- 6 legislature authorizes revenue bonds to be issued to finance
- 7 educational and related facilities for the institution, and the
- 8 bonds are issued for that purpose; or
- 9 $\underline{(2)}$ 2,500 full-time students for one semester $\underline{\text{if the}}$
- 10 conditions specified by Subdivision (1) are not satisfied.
- 11 SECTION 3. This Act takes effect immediately if it receives
- 12 a vote of two-thirds of all the members elected to each house, as
- 13 provided by Section 39, Article III, Texas Constitution. If this
- 14 Act does not receive the vote necessary for immediate effect, this
- 15 Act takes effect September 1, 2005.
