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- BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:
- 4 SECTION 1. The heading to Subchapter H, Chapter 51,
- 5 Education Code, is amended to read as follows:
- 6 SUBCHAPTER H. GUIDELINES FOR ACADEMIC AND OTHER REPORTS

7 BY INSTITUTIONS OF HIGHER EDUCATION

- 8 SECTION 2. Subchapter H, Chapter 51, Education Code, is 9 amended by adding Section 51.4032 to read as follows:
- 10 Sec. 51.4032. ANNUAL REPORT OF PARTICIPATION IN HIGHER
- 11 EDUCATION. Not later than July 31 of each year and in the form
- 12 prescribed by the coordinating board, each general academic
- 13 teaching institution and medical and dental unit as defined in
- 14 <u>Section 61.003 shall provide to the Texas Higher Education</u>
- 15 Coordinating Board a report describing the composition of the
- 16 <u>institution's entering class of students.</u> The report must include
- 17 a demographic breakdown of the class, including a breakdown by
- 18 race, ethnicity, and economic status. A report submitted by a
- 19 general academic teaching institution or medical and dental unit as
- 20 defined in Section 61.003 must include separate demographic
- 21 breakdowns of the students admitted under Sections 51.803, 51.804,
- 22 <u>and 51.805.</u>

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- SECTION 3. Subsection (b), Section 61.086, Education Code,
- 24 is amended to read as follows:

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- 1 (b) Each institution of higher education shall implement
- 2 the uniform strategy developed under Subsection (a). Each
- 3 institution shall report [annually] to the board as part of the
- 4 annual report submitted under Section 51.4032 the manner in which
- 5 the institution has implemented the uniform strategy.
- 6 SECTION 4. Section 51.806, Education Code, is repealed.
- 7 SECTION 5. Each public institution of higher education in
- 8 this state shall submit the first report required by Section
- 9 51.4032, Education Code, as added by this Act, not later than July
- 10 31, 2006.
- 11 SECTION 6. This Act takes effect immediately if it receives
- 12 a vote of two-thirds of all the members elected to each house, as
- 13 provided by Section 39, Article III, Texas Constitution. If this
- 14 Act does not receive the vote necessary for immediate effect, this
- 15 Act takes effect September 1, 2005.
