- 3 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:
- 4 SECTION 1. Subsection (a), Section 30.05, Penal Code, is 5 amended to read as follows:
- 6 (a) A person commits an offense if he enters or remains on or
 7 in property, including <u>a recreational vehicle park and</u> an aircraft
 8 or other vehicle, of another without effective consent or he enters
 9 or remains in a building of another without effective consent and
 10 he:
- 11 (1) had notice that the entry was forbidden; or
- 12 (2) received notice to depart but failed to do so.
- SECTION 2. Subsection (b), Section 30.05, Penal Code, is amended by adding Subdivision (7) to read as follows:
- 15 (7) "Recreational vehicle park" means a tract of land
- 16 that has rental spaces for two or more recreational vehicles, as
- defined by Section 522.004, Transportation Code.
- SECTION 3. (a) The change in law made by this Act applies
- only to an offense committed on or after the effective date of this
- 20 Act. For purposes of this section, an offense is committed before
- 21 the effective date of this Act if any element of the offense occurs
- 22 before the effective date.
- 23 (b) An offense committed before the effective date of this
- 24 Act is covered by the law in effect when the offense was committed,

- 1 and the former law is continued in effect for that purpose.
- 2 SECTION 4. This Act takes effect September 1, 2005.
