- 5 SECTION 1. Section 772.114(c), Health and Safety Code, is
- 6 amended to read as follows:
- 7 (c) The rate of the fee may not exceed  $\underline{six}$  [three] percent of
- 8 the monthly base rate charged a service user by the principal
- 9 service supplier in the participating jurisdiction.
- 10 SECTION 2. The change in law made by this Act applies only
- 11 to a fee that is imposed on or after the effective date of this Act.
- 12 A fee that is imposed before the effective date of this Act is
- governed by the law in effect when the fee was imposed, and that law
- is continued in effect for that purpose.
- 15 SECTION 3. This Act takes effect September 1, 2005.
