1-8 A BILL TO BE ENTITLED
1-9 AN ACT

1-10 relating to the designation of the El Camino Real East/West
1-11 Corridor.

1-12 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:

1-13 SECTION 1. Subchapter B, Chapter 225, Transportation Code,
1-14 is amended by adding Section 225.0401 to read as follows:

1-15 Sec. 225.0401. EL CAMINO REAL EAST/WEST CORRIDOR. (a) The
1-16 parts of State Highways 7, 21, and 103, United States Highway 290,
1-17 and Interstate Highway 10 from Pendleton to El Paso are designated
1-18 as the El Camino Real East/West Corridor.

1-19 (b) To the extent the El Camino Real East/West Commission
1-20 reimburses the department for the department's costs, the
1-21 department shall:

1-22 (1) design and construct markers in consultation with
1-23 the El Camino Real East/West Commission to be placed along the
1-24 corridor indicating the highway number, the designation as the El
1-25 Camino Real East/West Corridor, and any other appropriate
1-26 information; and

1-27 (2) erect a marker at each end of the corridor and at
1-28 appropriate intermediate sites along the corridor.

1-29 SECTION 2. This Act takes effect immediately if it receives
1-30 a vote of two-thirds of all the members elected to each house, as
1-31 provided by Section 39, Article III, Texas Constitution. If this
1-32 Act does not receive the vote necessary for immediate effect, this
1-33 Act takes effect September 1, 2005.
