10	the purposes of this subsection, the use of a credit history or

12	(1) is not considered discrimination when used in
13	determining the applicability of a security deposit requirement;
14	and
15	(2) is considered discrimination when used:
16	(A) in denying or pricing service to a buyer or
17	<pre>potential buyer; or</pre>
18	(B) in limiting a buyer's ability to switch
19	service providers.
20	(i) In this section:
21	(1) "Credit history" means information regarding ar
22	individual's past history of:
23	(A) financial responsibility;
24	(B) payment habits; or

(C) creditworthiness.

- 2 (2) "Credit score" means a score, grade, or value that
 3 is derived by using data from a credit history in any type of model,
 4 method, or program for the purpose of grading or ranking credit
 5 report data, whether derived electronically, from an algorithm,
 6 through a computer software application model or program, or
 7 through any other analogous process.
- 8 SECTION 2. This Act takes effect September 1, 2005.
