4	SECTION 1. Subsection (b), Section 3, Article 9026c,
5	Revised Statutes, is amended to read as follows:
6	(b) In addition to the notice provided to each renter who
7	purchases a damage waiver, a rental company shall post in a
8	conspicuous location where the waiver is being offered the
9	following notice:
10	Notice to Texas Residents Regarding Damage Waivers
11	Your personal automobile insurance policy may or may
12	not provide coverage for your responsibility for the
13	loss of or damage to a rented vehicle during the rental
14	term. Before deciding whether to purchase a damage
15	waiver, you may wish to determine whether your
16	automobile insurance policy provides you coverage for
17	rental vehicle damage or loss. [ <del>The Texas personal</del>
18	automobile insurance policy provides coverage with NO
19	DEDUCTIBLE for the legal liabilities of the
20	policyholder in connection with the loss of or damage
21	to a rented vehicle, except for damages caused
22	intentionally, up to the maximum of the property
23	damage limits under your liability coverage.] If you
24	file a claim under your personal automobile insurance

policy, your insurance company may choose to nonrenew
your policy at your renewal date, but may do so only if
you are at fault for the claim.

SECTION 2. The change in law made by this Act applies only to a rental agreement entered into on or after the effective date of this Act. A rental agreement entered into before the effective date of this Act is governed by the law in effect when the rental agreement was entered into, and the former law is continued in effect for that purpose.

10 SECTION 3. This Act takes effect immediately if it receives 11 a vote of two-thirds of all the members elected to each house, as 12 provided by Section 39, Article III, Texas Constitution. If this 13 Act does not receive the vote necessary for immediate effect, this 14 Act takes effect September 1, 2005.
