Sec. 132.024. LICENSE <u>EXPIRATION</u> [YEAR]. [(a) Except as provided by Subsection (b) of this section, a license required by this chapter is valid from September 1 of each year through August 31 of the following year.

[(b)] A license issued <u>or renewed</u> [to a new business] under
this chapter <u>expires on the first anniversary of</u> [is valid from] the
date of issuance <u>or renewal</u> [through the following August 31,
unless the new license is issued in August, in which event the
license is valid through August 31 of the following year].

SECTION 5. The change in law made by this Act applies only to a license issued or renewed on or after the effective date of this Act. A license issued or renewed before the effective date of this Act is governed by the law in effect when the license was issued or renewed, and the former law is continued in effect for that purpose.
