1-8 relating to the repeal of the statutory provision regarding the
1-9 adoption and use by the Texas Water Development Board of a capital
1-10 spending plan for certain state-funded water-related programs
1-11 under the board's jurisdiction.

1-12 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:

1-13 SECTION 1. Section 6.110, Water Code, is repealed.

1-14 SECTION 2. This Act takes effect immediately if it receives
1-15 a vote of two-thirds of all the members elected to each house, as
1-16 provided by Section 39, Article III, Texas Constitution. If this
1-17 Act does not receive the vote necessary for immediate effect, this
1-18 Act takes effect September 1, 2005.
