4	BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:
5	SECTION 1. Section 11.163, Education Code, is amended by
6	adding Subsections (d) and (e) to read as follows:
7	(d) The employment policy must:
8	(1) permit school district employees to communicate
9	directly with a member of the board of trustees without restriction
10	regarding a matter relating to the operation of the district; and
11	(2) provide that a trustee receiving a communication
12	from a district employee may keep the identity of the employee
13	confidential.
14	(e) A member of the board of trustees may inquire about the
15	substance of a communication from a district employee at a board of
16	trustees meeting. The inquiry is subject to Section 551.042,
17	Government Code, except that the trustees may also propose and
18	decide that the substance of the inquiry be investigated and
19	reported to the board at a subsequent meeting.
20	SECTION 2. This Act takes effect immediately if it receives
21	a vote of two-thirds of all the members elected to each house, as
22	provided by Section 39, Article III, Texas Constitution. If this
23	Act does not receive the vote necessary for immediate effect, this
