## A BILL TO BE ENTITLED

1	AN ACT
2	relating to providing information and other services relating to
3	emergency contraception to sexual assault survivors.
4	BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:
5	SECTION 1. Subtitle G, Title 4, Health and Safety Code, is
6	amended by adding Chapter 322 to read as follows:
7	CHAPTER 322. EMERGENCY SERVICES FOR SURVIVORS OF SEXUAL ASSAULT
8	Sec. 322.001. DEFINITIONS. In this chapter:
9	(1) "Health care facility" means:
10	(A) a general or special hospital as defined by
11	Section 241.003;
12	(B) an ambulatory surgical center as defined by
13	Section 243.002; and
14	(C) a facility designated as a trauma facility
15	under Chapter 773.
16	(2) "Sexual assault" means any act as described by
17	Section 22.011 or 22.021, Penal Code.
18	(3) "Sexual assault survivor" means an individual who
19	is a victim of a sexual assault, regardless of whether a report is
20	made or a conviction is obtained in the incident.
21	Sec. 322.002. INFORMATION FORM. (a) Each health care
22	facility shall develop an information form for sexual assault
23	survivors that includes information regarding emergency
24	contraception.

1	(b) Emergency contraception information contained in the
2	form must be medically and factually accurate and unbiased. A
3	health care facility may use appropriate medical organizations and
4	associations, including the American College of Obstetricians and
5	Gynecologists, as resources in developing the form.
6	(c) The information form shall be published in:
7	(1) an easily comprehensible form; and
8	(2) a typeface large enough to be clearly legible.
9	(d) The governing body or other managing authority of a
10	health care facility shall annually review the information form to
11	determine if changes to the contents of the form are necessary.
12	Sec. 322.003. EMERGENCY SERVICES RELATING TO EMERGENCY
13	CONTRACEPTION. After a sexual assault survivor arrives at a health
14	care facility for emergency care following an alleged sexual
15	assault, the facility shall:
16	(1) provide the sexual assault survivor with the
17	information form required under Section 322.002;
18	(2) orally communicate to the sexual assault survivor
19	the information regarding emergency contraception contained in the
20	information form provided under Subdivision (1);
21	(3) if indicated by the history of contact, orally
22	inform the sexual assault survivor that the survivor may request
23	and be provided with a prescription for emergency contraception at
24	the facility; and

medically contraindicated, provide the sexual assault survivor

with a prescription for emergency contraception immediately on

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(4) if indicated by the history of contact and if not

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- 1 <u>request of the survivor.</u>
- 2 SECTION 2. This Act takes effect September 1, 2005.
