9	(2) "Contraband" means property of any nature,
10	including real, personal, tangible, or intangible, that is:

12	(i) any first or second degree felony under
13	the Penal Code;
14	(ii) any felony under Section 15.031(b),
15	20.05, 21.11, 38.04, Subchapter B of Chapter 43, or Chapter 29, 30,
16	31, 32, 33, 33A, or 35, Penal Code; or
17	(iii) any felony under The Securities Act
18	(Article 581-1 et seq., Vernon's Texas Civil Statutes);
19	(B) used or intended to be used in the commission

21	(i) any felony under Chapter 481, Health

and Safety Code;

(ii) any felony under Chapter 483, Health

- 1 before the effective date of this Act is covered by the law in
- 2 effect when the offense was committed, and the former law is
- 3 continued in effect for that purpose. For purposes of this section,
- 4 an offense is committed before the effective date of this Act if any
- 5 element of the offense occurs before that date.
- 6 SECTION 3. This Act takes effect September 1, 2005.
