1-8 relating to application of the professional prosecutors law to the
1-9 district attorney for the 112th Judicial District.

1-10 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:

1-11 SECTION 1. Section 46.002, Government Code, is amended to
1-12 read as follows:

1-13 Sec. 46.002. PROSECUTORS SUBJECT TO CHAPTER. This chapter
1-14 applies to all county prosecutors and to the following state
1-15 prosecutors:

1-16 (1) the district attorneys for the 1st, 2nd, 8th, 9th,
1-17 12th, 18th, 21st, 23rd, 25th, 26th, 27th, 29th, 31st, 32nd, 33rd,

1-22 220th, 229th, 235th, 253rd, 258th, 259th, 266th, 268th, 271st,
1-23 278th, 286th, 329th, 349th, and 355th judicial districts;

1-24 (2) the criminal district attorneys for the counties
1-25 of Anderson, Austin, Bastrop, Bexar, Bowie, Brazoria, Caldwell,
1-26 Calhoun, Cass, Collin, Comal, Dallas, Deaf Smith, Denton, Eastland,
1-27 Galveston, Grayson, Gregg, Harrison, Hays, Hidalgo, Jasper,
1-28 Jefferson, Kaufman, Lubbock, McLennan, Madison, Navarro, Newton,
1-29 Panola, Polk, Randall, Rockwall, San Jacinto, Smith, Tarrant,
1-30 Taylor, Tyler, Upshur, Van Zandt, Victoria, Walker, Waller,
1-31 Wichita, Wood, and Yoakum; and

1-32 (3) the county attorneys performing the duties of
1-33 district attorneys in the counties of Andrews, Callahan, Cameron,
1-34 Castro, Colorado, Crosby, Ellis, Falls, Fannin, Freestone, Lamar,
1-35 Lamb, Lampasas, Lee, Limestone, Marion, Milam, Morris, Ochiltree,
1-36 Orange, Rains, Red River, Robertson, Rusk, Terry, Webb, and
1-37 Willacy.

1-38 SECTION 2. Section 43.152, Government Code, is amended to
1-39 read as follows:

1-40 Sec. 43.152. 112TH JUDICIAL DISTRICT. [~~(a)~~] The voters of
1-41 the 112th Judicial District elect a district attorney.

1-42 [~~(b) The commissioners court of one or more of the counties
1-43 comprising the district may supplement the state salary of the
1-44 district attorney by an additional salary of \$4,800 a year. The
1-45 supplemental salary may be paid from the officers' salary funds of
1-46 the counties, if adequate. If the officers' salary fund of a county
1-47 is inadequate, the commissioners court shall transfer the necessary
1-48 funds from the general fund of the county to the officers' salary
1-49 fund.]~~

1-50 SECTION 3. This Act takes effect September 1, 2005.
