3	BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:
4	SECTION 1. Section 1202.001(2), Occupations Code, is
5	amended to read as follows:
6	(2) "Construction site [office] building" means a
7	commercial structure that is:
8	(A) not open to the public; and
9	(B) used <u>for any purpose</u> [as an office] at a
LO	commercial site by a person constructing a building, road, bridge,
L1	utility, or other infrastructure or improvement to real property.
L2	SECTION 2. Section 1202.003(d), Occupations Code, is
L3	amended to read as follows:
L4	(d) An industrialized building includes a permanent
L5	commercial structure and a commercial structure designed to be
L6	transported from one commercial site to another commercial site but
L7	does not include:
L8	(1) a commercial structure that exceeds three stories
L9	or 49 feet in height as measured from the finished grade elevation
20	at the building entrance to the peak of the roof; or
21	(2) a commercial building or structure that is:
22	(A) installed in a manner other than on a
23	permanent foundation; and

(B) either:

- 1 (i) not open to the public; or
- 2 <u>(ii)</u> less than 1,500 square feet in total
- 3 area and used other than as a school or a place of religious
- 4 worship.
- 5 SECTION 3. Section 1202.203, Occupations Code, is amended
- 6 by amending Subsection (b) and adding Subsection (d) to read as
- 7 follows:
- 8 (b) An approved third-party inspector shall perform on-site
- 9 inspections of industrialized housing [and buildings] to be located
- 10 outside the municipality.
- 11 (d) If required by commission rule, an approved third-party
- 12 inspector shall perform on-site inspections of industrialized
- 13 <u>buildings to be located outside the municipality.</u>
- 14 SECTION 4. Section 1202.204(b), Occupations Code, is
- 15 amended to read as follows:
- 16 (b) The commission by rule shall exempt a construction site
- 17 [office] building from the requirements of this section.
- 18 SECTION 5. Section 1202.003(c), Occupations Code, is
- 19 repealed.
- 20 SECTION 6. The changes in law made by this Act apply to any
- 21 building or structure at a commercial site regardless of the date of
- 22 installation of that building or structure.
- 23 SECTION 7. This Act takes effect September 1, 2005.
