- 2 relating to registration fee credits for the owners of certain dry

- 5 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:
- 6 SECTION 1. Section 374.104(b), Health and Safety Code, is
- 7 repealed.
- 8 SECTION 2. An owner of a dry cleaning facility who files an
- 9 option not to participate in the dry cleaning facility release fund
- on or before December 31, 2005, and whose facility is designated as
- 11 nonparticipating by the commission under Section 374.104, Health
- 12 and Safety Code, as amended by this Act, is entitled to a credit
- against future registration fees under Section 374.102, Health and
- 14 Safety Code, to the extent that a registration fee paid in 2004 or
- 15 2005 exceeded the amount due for a nonparticipating dry cleaning
- 16 facility.
- SECTION 3. Not later than December 31, 2005, the Texas
- 18 Commission on Environmental Quality shall adopt rules governing
- 19 applications to register a dry cleaning facility as
- 20 nonparticipating in the dry cleaning facility release fund under
- 21 Section 374.104, Health and Safety Code, as amended by this Act.
- 22 SECTION 4. This Act takes effect immediately if it receives
- 23 a vote of two-thirds of all the members elected to each house, as
- 24 provided by Section 39, Article III, Texas Constitution. If this

- 1 Act does not receive the vote necessary for immediate effect, this
- 2 Act takes effect September 1, 2005.
