    (a) In this section, "gift card" includes a gift card, the value of
    which is intended to be electronically readable, or a gift
        certificate.
            (b) A}\mathrm{ condition relating to the use of a gift card is void if
        it provides that:
            (1) the value of the card decreases over a period of
        time; or
            (2) a fee is charged against the balance of the card
        after a certain period of time.
            (c) Subsection (b) does not affect the validity of a gift
        card containing a condition that is void under Subsection (b).
            (d) This section does not apply to:
                (1) a calling card issued by a prepaid calling card
        company regulated under Section 55.253, Utilities Code; or
            (2) a gift card distributed by the issuer to a consumer
        under an awards, loyalty, or promotional program without the
        consumer giving money in exchange for the card.
            (e) This section does not create a cause of action against a
