- 6 Code, is amended to read as follows:
- 7 Sec. 552.1175. CONFIDENTIALITY OF ADDRESSES, TELEPHONE
- 8 NUMBERS, SOCIAL SECURITY NUMBERS, AND PERSONAL FAMILY INFORMATION
- 9 OF PEACE OFFICERS, COUNTY JAILERS, SECURITY OFFICERS, AND EMPLOYEES
- 10 OF THE TEXAS DEPARTMENT OF CRIMINAL JUSTICE OR A PROSECUTOR'S
- 11 OFFICE.
- 12 SECTION 2. Section 552.1175(a), Government Code, is amended
- 13 to read as follows:
- 14 (a) This section applies only to:
- 15 (1) peace officers as defined by Article 2.12, Code of
- 16 Criminal Procedure;
- 17 (2) county jailers as defined by Section 1701.001,
- 18 Occupations Code;
- 19 (3) current or former employees of the Texas
- 20 Department of Criminal Justice or of the predecessor in function of
- 21 the department or any division of the department; [and]
- 22 (4) commissioned security officers as defined by
- 23 Section 1702.002, Occupations Code; and
- 24 (5) employees of a district attorney, criminal

- 1 <u>district attorney</u>, or county attorney whose jurisdiction includes
- 2 <u>any criminal law matters</u>.
- 3 SECTION 3. This Act takes effect immediately if it receives
- 4 a vote of two-thirds of all the members elected to each house, as
- 5 provided by Section 39, Article III, Texas Constitution. If this
- 6 Act does not receive the vote necessary for immediate effect, this
- 7 Act takes effect September 1, 2005.
