## A BILL TO BE ENTITLED

2	relating to reducing paperwork required of school districts and
3	school district employees.
4	BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:
5	SECTION 1. Subchapter C, Chapter 7, Education Code, is
6	amended by adding Section 7.060 to read as follows:
7	Sec. 7.060. REDUCING PAPERWORK. (a) At least once each
8	even-numbered year, the commissioner shall review and, to the
9	greatest extent practicable, reduce written reports and other
10	paperwork required of a school district by the agency.
11	(b) The commissioner shall adopt a policy that limits
12	written reports and other paperwork that a principal or classroom
13	teacher may be required by the agency to complete.
14	SECTION 2. Section 39.075, Education Code, is amended by
15	adding Subsection (b-1) to read as follows:
16	(b-1) The commissioner may authorize special accreditation
17	investigations to be conducted in response to repeated complaints
18	submitted to the agency concerning imposition of excessive
19	paperwork requirements on classroom teachers.
20	SECTION 3. Subsection (b-1), Section 39.075, Education
21	Code, as added by this Act, applies beginning with the 2005-2006
22	school year.
23	SECTION 4. This Act takes effect immediately if it receives
24	a vote of two-thirds of all the members elected to each house, as

1	provided by Section 39, Article III, Texas Constitution. If	this
2	Act does not receive the vote necessary for immediate effect,	this
3	Act takes effect September 1, 2005.
