A BILL TO BE ENTITLED

1	AN ACT
2	relating to prices charged for the provision of health care
3	services.
4	BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:
5	SECTION 1. Section 552.001, Insurance Code, as effective
6	April 1, 2005, is amended to read as follows:
7	Sec. 552.001. APPLICABILITY OF CHAPTER. (a) This chapter
8	does not apply to the provision of a health care service to a:
9	(1) Medicaid or Medicare patient $[+]$ or a patient who
10	is covered by a federal, state, or local government-sponsored
11	indigent health care program;
12	(2) <u>financially or</u> medically indigent person who
13	qualifies for indigent health care services based on:
14	(A) a sliding fee scale; or
15	(B) a written charity care policy established by
16	a health care provider; or
17	(3) person who is not covered by a health insurance
18	policy or other health benefit plan that provides benefits for the
19	services and qualifies for services for the uninsured based on a
20	written policy established by a health care provider.
21	(b) This chapter does not permit the establishment of health
22	care provider policies or contracts that violate any other state or
23	federal law.

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(c) This chapter does not prohibit a health care provider

- 1 from entering into a contract to provide services covered by a
- 2 health insurance policy or other health benefit plan with:
- 3 (1) the issuer of the health insurance policy or other
- 4 health benefit plan; or
- 5 (2) a preferred provider organization that contracts
- 6 with the issuer of the health insurance policy or other health
- 7 benefit plan.
- 8 SECTION 2. The change in law made by this Act applies only
- 9 to charges for health care services provided on or after the
- 10 effective date of this Act. Charges for health care services
- 11 provided before the effective date of this Act are governed by the
- 12 law in effect immediately before that date, and that law is
- 13 continued in effect for that purpose.
- 14 SECTION 3. This Act takes effect immediately if it receives
- 15 a vote of two-thirds of all the members elected to each house, as
- 16 provided by Section 39, Article III, Texas Constitution. If this
- 17 Act does not receive the vote necessary for immediate effect, this
- 18 Act takes effect September 1, 2005.
