## A BILL TO BE ENTITLED

5	SECTION 1. Subchapter G, Chapter 51, Education Code, is
6	amended by adding Section 51.355 to read as follows:
7	Sec. 51.355. PUBLIC TESTIMONY AT CERTAIN MEETINGS OF
8	GOVERNING BOARDS OF GENERAL ACADEMIC TEACHING INSTITUTIONS.
9	(a) In this section, "general academic teaching institution" has
10	the meaning assigned by Section 61.003.
11	(b) The governing board of each general academic teaching
12	institution or of a university system that includes one or more
13	component general academic teaching institutions shall adopt a
14	policy that allows the public to present, for a reasonable amount of
15	time and for any item on the agenda, both written and oral testimony
16	at a regular meeting of the board.
17	(c) The governing board shall consider the public testimony
18	presented to the board on an issue before making a decision on the
19	issue.
20	SECTION 2. The governing board of each general academic
21	teaching institution or university system shall adopt the policy
22	required by Section 51.355, Education Code, as added by this Act,
23	not later than October 1, 2005.

1	a vote of two-thirds of all the members elected to each house, as
2	provided by Section 39, Article III, Texas Constitution. If this
