4	BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:
5	SECTION 1. Subchapter A, Chapter 130, Education Code, is
6	amended by adding Section 130.0034 to read as follows:
7	Sec. 130.0034. TUITION FOR REPEATED COURSES. (a) The
8	governing board of a public junior college district may charge a
9	student a higher rate of tuition than the tuition that would
10	otherwise be charged for a course in which the student enrolls if
11	the student has previously enrolled in the same course or a course
12	of substantially the same content and level two or more times after
13	the 2003-2004 academic year.
14	(b) This section does not apply to a non-degree-credit
15	developmental course.
16	(c) The total amount of tuition charged to the student under
17	this section for the repeated course may not exceed the full cost of
18	instruction for the course with respect to the student.
19	SECTION 2. This Act takes effect immediately if it receives
20	a vote of two-thirds of all the members elected to each house, as
21	provided by Section 39, Article III, Texas Constitution. If this
22	Act does not receive the vote necessary for immediate effect, this
23	Act takes effect September 1, 2005.
