## A BILL TO BE ENTITLED

1 AN ACT

- 2 relating to tuition and other charges and fees imposed by the
- 3 governing board of a junior college district.
- 4 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:
- 5 SECTION 1. Section 130.003(b), Education Code, is amended
- 6 to read as follows:
- 7 (b) To be eligible for and to receive a proportionate share
- 8 of the appropriation, a public junior college must:
- 9 (1) be certified as a public junior college as
- 10 prescribed in Section 61.063 [of this code];
- 11 (2) offer a minimum of 24 semester hours of vocational
- 12 and/or terminal courses;
- 13 (3) have complied with all existing laws, rules, and
- 14 regulations governing the establishment and maintenance of public
- 15 junior colleges;
- 16 (4) collect, from each full-time and part-time student
- 17 enrolled, matriculation and other session fees in the amounts
- 18 required by law or in the amounts set by the governing board of the
- 19 junior college district as authorized by this title;
- 20 (5) grant, when properly applied for, the scholarships
- 21 and tuition exemptions provided for in this code; and
- 22 (6) for a public junior college established on or
- 23 after September 1, 1986, levy and collect ad valorem taxes as
- 24 provided by law for the operation and maintenance of the public

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- 1 junior college.
- 2 SECTION 2. Section 130.084, Education Code, is amended to
- 3 read as follows:
- 4 Sec. 130.084. POWERS AND DUTIES. (a) The governing board
- 5 [ $\frac{\text{of trustees}}{\text{of } \underline{a}}$ ] of  $\underline{a}$  junior college  $\underline{\text{districts}}$ ] shall be
- 6 governed in the establishment, management, and control of <u>a public</u>
- 7 [the] junior college in the district by the general law governing
- 8 the establishment, management, and control of independent school
- 9 districts insofar as the general law is applicable.
- 10 (b) The governing board of a junior college district may set
- and collect with respect to a public junior college in the district
- 12 any amount of tuition, rentals, rates, charges, or fees the board
- 13 considers necessary for the efficient operation of the college,
- 14 except that a tuition rate set under this subsection must satisfy
- the requirements of Section 54.051(n). The governing board may set
- 16 <u>a different tuition rate for each program, course, or course level</u>
- 17 offered by the college, including a program, course, or course
- 18 level to which a provision of Section 54.051 applies, as the
- 19 governing board considers appropriate to reflect course costs or to
- 20 promote efficiency or another rational purpose.
- SECTION 3. Sections 130.003(b) and 130.084, Education Code,
- 22 as amended by this Act, apply beginning with tuition charged for the
- 23 2005 fall semester. Tuition charged for an academic period before
- the 2005 fall semester is covered by the law in effect immediately
- 25 before the effective date of this Act, and the former law is
- 26 continued in effect for that purpose.
- 27 SECTION 4. This Act takes effect immediately if it receives

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- 1 a vote of two-thirds of all the members elected to each house, as
- 2 provided by Section 39, Article III, Texas Constitution. If this
- 3 Act does not receive the vote necessary for immediate effect, this
- 4 Act takes effect September 1, 2005.
